Waiver Agreement

THIS AGREEMENT is made between Miss Rodeo Wisconsin Pageant Association, Inc., Glenwood City Rodeo committee, City of Glenwood, State of Wisconsin, hereinafter referred to as "Pageant" and _____ City of _____ State of Wisconsin, hereinafter referred to as "Contestant".

WHEREAS, Pageant conducts the Miss Teen Rodeo Wisconsin Pageant (hereinafter referred to as "Contest"), including the creation, publication and administration of all rules and regulations relating thereto and WHEREAS, Contestant desires to compete in the contest,

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth herein, the mutual benefits derived here

from and other good and valuable consideration provided each unto the other, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged by delivery hereof, it is agreed:

1. Contestant represents she (a) has read all Contest rules and regulations; (b) has received a complete copy of all Contest rules and/or regulations, and (d) understands each and every rule and/or regulation, and (e) had full opportunity to present all questions regarding the rules and regulations, and all questions have been fully answered.
2. Contestant will adhere to and comply with all Contest rules and regulations.
3. Contestant will upon observing and/or being informed of any violation of, and/or perceived violation of any Contest rule and/or regulation:
 - a. Inform Pageant of the alleged and/or perceived violation, at the earliest and most proximate time to the instance, but in no event, not to be less than two hours of the scheduled naming of the contest winner(s) and
 - b. In no way act to withhold information from Pageant and/or from other third party contestant(s), as to deprive Pageant of the opportunity to determine alleged violations.

In this regard, Miss Teen Rodeo Wisconsin Pageant Chairmen is hereby designated as the person to receive any and all alleged and/or perceived rules violation(s).

4. Unless timely reported as defined above in paragraph 3 (a), each and every alleged violation of, and/or perceived violation of, Contest rules and/or regulations shall be deemed waived, and the complaining party shall be stopped from presenting allegations regarding the same.
5. Pageant agrees that with respect to reported violation(s), it shall (a) timely and fully investigate each allegation, (b) report its findings to the person presenting the allegation and (c) enforce its rules and regulations against any contestant found to have violated the same.
6. Contestant agrees the Pageant is the sole and exclusive entity to determine the existence and/or nonexistence of a violation of the rules and regulations, and that Contestant shall be finally bound by

Pageant's determination, the same to be final and binding between the parties hereto. Contestant further agrees that Pageant is the sole and exclusive authority to interpret and enforce its rules and regulations.

7. In any legal proceeding in which Pageant shall be awarded any judgment enforcing any term and/or condition of this Agreement, Pageant, its employees, agents, sponsors, and/or representatives shall also receive a reasonable attorney fees and all costs incurred in the prosecution and/or defense of said action.

Participant Release Form

In consideration of my participation in the Miss Teen Rodeo Wisconsin Pageant, in accordance with the rules of such pageant, and for the other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is acknowledged, I, the undersigned consent, represent, warrant and agree to the following:

1. **Authorization to Use Images.** I authorize Miss Rodeo Wisconsin Pageant Association, Inc. and their licensees, representatives, successors and assigns, (collectively MRWPA) to use my name, voice, likeness, images or signature (collectively referred to as "Images") in any manner and in any medium and for any purpose which they choose, including without limitation print, radio, television, audio-visual recording, electronic or magnetic media, computer disks, computer file servers, CD-ROM's on the Internet, including the World Wide Web, or in any type of computer network or for advertising in or for any of those media. The Images used may include still images, motion pictures, videotape, audio-visual, live or recorded broadcasts. I further waive any right I may have to approve any Image or its use in any future materials. I further grant MRWPA the right to edit, alter or modify in any manner it deems appropriate.
2. **Perpetual Right to Use Images.** This authorization includes perpetual license to use my Images and to license or permit others to use, post, copy or reproduce such Images. I further authorize MRWPA, or their licensees to alter, edit or modify the appearance of my Images in any manner they deem appropriate for such use in such media.
3. **Assignment of Any Rights in Images.** To the extent I may have any rights in the Images; I assign any rights I may have in the Images, including copyright, to the MRWPA.
4. **Image Release.** I release and discharge MRWPA, its licensees, successors, assigns, agents, employees and representatives from any and all claims, demands and liabilities arising out of or related to their use of my Images in any manner reasonably contemplated by this agreement, including without limitation any claims for defamation, libel, slander, invasion of privacy or infringement of the right of publicity.
5. **Indemnity.** I agree to indemnify and hold MRWPA harmless from any and all claims, demands, actions or causes of action (including attorneys' fees) based upon, arising out of or related to: (a) MRWPA use of my Images as described in this agreement, (b) any violation by me of this agreement, and (c) any false or misleading statements made by me in connection with the information I have provided to MRWPA related to the subject matter of this agreement.

6. Right to Edit Images. It shall be within MRWPA's sole discretion to determine if, where, how and in what manner my Images are used. I grant MRWPA the right to alter or edit the Images as it may deem necessary or appropriate.
7. No Additional Compensation. Except as specifically stated otherwise in a written agreement by MRWPA I acknowledge that no additional compensation is due to me for the use of my Images as contemplated by this agreement.
8. Arbitration. In the event a dispute arising out of or related of the subject matter of this agreement, I agree that such matter will be resolved by binding arbitration by an arbitrator to be mutually selected by the parties. In the event that the parties are not able to agree upon an arbitrator one shall be selected in accordance with the rules for commercial arbitration of the American Arbitration Association and the arbitration shall be held in accordance with the commercial arbitration rules of the American Arbitration Association. Any such arbitration shall be held in Wisconsin.
9. Assumption of Risk/Acknowledgement of Inherent Danger. As part of my participation in the Miss Rodeo Wisconsin Pageant, I understand that I will be asked to participate in certain rodeo activities, related activities or other activities where horses, livestock and other large animals may be present or involved. I represent and warrant that I am experienced in these and similar activities. These activities are or may be inherently risky, and I know that the risks involved include the risks of being involved in these activities. I further represent and warrant that I am voluntarily participating in these activities knowing the potential risks involved. I release and discharge MRWPA and all of its employees, agents, representatives, volunteers, officers and director from any and all liability of every kind and nature that may be involved in participating in these types of activities.
